There are several easy ways to add Greenwich Land Trust to your will:

MONETARY CONTRIBUTIONS

Remembering Greenwich Land Trust with a monetary contribution is easy to do. Your attorney can prepare a simple amendment to your will.

Suggested wording to share with your attorney:

I hereby give to Greenwich Land Trust, a Connecticut corporation, the sum of \$...(or not to exceed ...% of my estate) for its general purposes.

Because GLT is a qualified 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, this contribution may result in reduced taxes to your estate.

STOCKS, BONDS & FINANCIAL ASSET CONTRIBUTIONS

GLT welcomes gifts to negotiable financial instruments such as common stocks, bonds, and certificates of deposit into its planned giving program. The language above can be modified for these contributions.

LAND & PERSONAL PROPERTY CONTRIBUTIONS

A donation of conservation land as a bequest to GLT is a truly wonderful legacy. This is a personal decision, which must be given careful consideration with family members. Contributions of land allow GLT to protect the land's important conservation values forever. GLT can also accept gifts of non-conservation land and personal property, the proceeds of which may be used to further our mission.

ADDITIONAL PLANNED GIVING OPPORTUNITIES

Naming Greenwich Land Trust as a beneficiary of a portion of your life insurance or retirement plan is another way to leave your legacy to protect the natural beauty of our community. This can be done through obtaining the beneficiary designation form from your retirement plan administrator or your insurance company.
