Celebrate Earth Day with The Greenwich Land Trust

Greenwich, CT- The Greenwich Land Trust's Earth Day Beautification Project is a terrific opportunity to spend Earth Day improving a beautiful natural space. Join us on **Saturday, April 25 from 10:00AM-1:00PM** at our Milbank Greene Preserve. The Milbank Greene Preserve, located near 610 Round Hill Road, encompasses a meadow and forest where The Greenwich Land Trust has been working to support native wildlife habitat.

Volunteers will help cut vines, remove invasive plants, and plant 100 native tree and shrub seedlings. There are also educational activities planned such as plant identification lessons and a wildlife release. Lunch will be provided by Whole Foods Market Greenwich.

Activities are suitable for all ages, but children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult. In case of rain, the activities will be postponed until Sunday, April 26. FREE.
