Trails Day Hike with The Greenwich Land Trust

Greenwich, CT- Join The Greenwich Land Trust for a Trails Day hike on Saturday, June 6th from 10:00am-12:30pm at the Audubon Greenwich and Greenwich Land Trust Preserves. Participants will experience an extensive guided nature walk through a combined Audubon and Land Trust trail system. This 3-mile hike will span a variety of habitats, including a red maple swamp, several meadows, a lake, and hillside forests. Visitors will hike some of the highest terrain in Greenwich and hear/see an array of plants and wildlife. Greenwich Land Trust staff will point out ecological and geological features of interest.

Terrain is moderately technical with some steep and rocky sections. Bring sturdy shoes, a bottle of water, and protection for the sun and insects. The event is free and families are encouraged to attend. Rain cancels the event. Pre-registration is recommended at www.gltrust.org.
