Welcome to the Louise Mueller Preserve and Greenwich Land Trust. This 4-acre preserve is designed for people of all ages and abilities to experience and enjoy nature.

- Grounds are open daily from dawn to dusk.
- Please enjoy the Virginia Gwynn Trail, an accessible trail with interpretive signage. The trail winds through a variety of local habits including native tall grass meadows, a small woodland, pollinator garden, wetland, and vegetable garden (please, no harvesting!).
- You are welcome to visit our administrative offices in the Farmhouse. The Farmhouse is open Monday – Friday 9-5pm.
- The Greenhouse, Potting Shed, and Barns are NOT open to the public. Volunteer opportunities are available. Please visit gltrust.org.
- Admission is free except during special events.
- GLT devotes much time and effort to maintaining these grounds for the enjoyment of the community and we hope you will consider showing your support with a donation.
- Bathrooms: Indoor bathrooms are accessible when the office is open. Monday – Friday 9-5pm.
- Parking: On site parking is available along the driveway in designated spaces. Parking is limited and cannot accommodate RVs, buses, trailers, and other large vehicles. Carpooling is encouraged and appreciated. If you plan to visit with a group of more than two cars please call ahead: 203-629-2151.
- Trash: We have a “Carry-In/Carry-Out” policy for all garbage. Please pack out all your trash.
- Dogs: All dogs must be leashed, and you must clean up after them.
- Greenwich Land Trust welcomes passive recreation including walking, birding, and nature study.
- The following activities are NOT allowed: collection of plant or animal specimens, camping, fires, hunting, bicycling, and the use of motorized vehicles.
- Enjoy the property at your own risk.
